(540) 721-2763:

- Take 220 South about 3+ miles past Boones Mill.
- Turn LEFT at Bojangles/Plateau Plaza onto Rte. 697.
- Go to end of the road (5mi.) and turn LEFT onto 122 North
- Go about 1 mile and turn Right onto 670 (Burnt Chimney Road). HELPFUL HINT - Follow 4H Center signs from Burnt Chimney.
- Go about 6 miles turn Right onto Lovely Valley Road (300 yards after Dot's store). Turn Right at end of road onto Craft's Ford Road.
- Go less than a mile and turn LEFT onto Three Quarter Point Rd.
- Go another mile and we are on the right. The address is 804 Three Quarter Point Rd. It's a sort of coffee/cream colored farm style house with a big flagpole in the front yard. There is plenty of parking in the back, front and street.

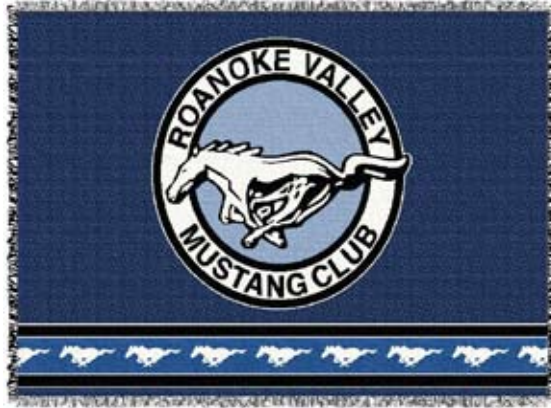
